What is it?

The Option Internationale du Baccalauréat allows for graduates to undertake third-level studies in France and in the UK. The International Section is a UK-France partnership.

In addition to the usual curriculum, OIB students complete the following through English:

- **4 hours of Language and Literature**
- **2 hours of History and Geography**
- **1h of Scientific Studies**

The teaching staff in charge of the OIB are native English speakers or have previous teaching experience at an English-speaking institution.

Who is it for?

The International Section is geared toward:

- Bilingual students
- Binational students with near-bilingual fluency
- Students coming back to the region after having lived for a prolonged stay abroad in an English-speaking country
- French students with an excellent level of English.

In any case, students must not be afraid of a challenge and have a keen interest in literature and history.

How to apply?

Application forms must be returned to the following address by **9 April 2021** at the latest:

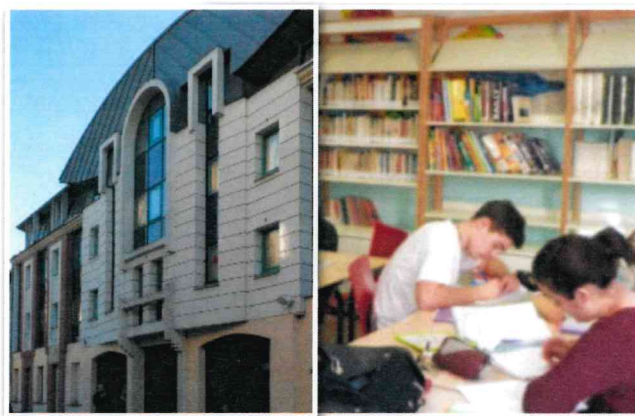
The admission tests will take place in **two stages**:

Written test (2 hours): Wednesday 14th April 2021 (MCQs, Reading Comprehension and Written Expression)

Oral test: Wednesday 21st April 2021. 10-minute exchange with a jury of two, based on a visual document (photograph, cartoon, painting...)
